Information and requirements about reduced and free entry to the museum

Concessions apply to the following:

- Students (regardless of age or nationality) with a current valid student card (university students, school students, postgraduates, and PhD students).
- Visitors over the age of 65 with a current valid passport.
- Member of a large family with a valid large family discount card.

Free entry applies to the following:

- Friends of the Museum (also with free entry. <u>Here</u> you will find more information about the Friends Programme)
- Visitors with disabilities with a valid disabled person's registration card. Included one companion or carer if the visitor requires assistance
- Large family group with a valid large family discount card.
- Children and young people under the age of 18.
- Holders of current valid Youth Cards (Carnet Joven) (only at the Museum ticket office)
- Unemployed visitors with an official and valid unemployment card.
- Teachers with valid documentation such as ITIC card
- Individual and institutional members of *ICOM* (International Council of Museums) who can show proof employment with the institutional member and whose membership coincides with the sticker's current year.

Reduced and free admission tickets collection requirements:

- Please take into account this step in order to arrive with time enough at the access control when your visit is booked.
- These tickets purchased in advance in the Museum ticket-office will also require status proof accreditation at the admission point to the galleries on the day of the visit.
