AVAILABILITY

RESERVATION

CANCELLATION

If you cancel your event less than 15 calendar days before the date, there will be a cancellation charge of 50% of the venue hire fee.

OUTDOOR SOUND

For the use of sound outdoors, a special permit has to be obtained from Madrid City Council. The museum will arrange this but requires at least 40 days' notice of the event and you will need to provide a detailed description of the sound equipment and elements that will be set up. We can't guarantee that the city council will grant permission, and if it is granted, the outdoor sound must not exceed the level stated in the permit.

SIMULTANEOUS USE OF VARIOUS ROOMS

If various rooms are rented at the same time, the full rate for the main room will be applied, plus the minimum rate for the associated room(s). The "main room" is understood here as the one with the highest rate of rental of those rented.

A WALK THROUGH THE HISTORY OF ART

The diversity of the Museum's collection means that we can offer versatile itineraries to meet your particular needs and interests. You can also visit the museum on multiple occasions and enjoy a different experience every time.

The **permanent collection** offers an excellent overview of the history of western painting through the key movements. It begins with the Trecento and continues with the Renaissance and Baroque periods, represented by German, Dutch, Spanish and Italian painters (15th, 16th and 17th centuries). The gallery devoted to Renaissance portraiture provides a fascinating insight into the different approaches adopted contemporaneously in Northern Europe and Italy. After viewing English and French paintings from the 18th century, we come to the 19th century, exploring North American art first and then European painters. Iconic works from movements such as Romanticism and Realism offer a foretaste of some of the changes that paved the way to European modern art and lead us on to Impressionism and Post-Impressionism with the work of artists like Monet, Van Gogh and Cézanne. Next, we come to the different avant-garde movements of the first half of the 20th century, featuring artists like Matisse, Kandinsky, Picasso and Dalí. The final galleries are devoted to European and North American art produced after the Second World War when the epicentre of the avant-garde shifted from Paris to New York, giving rise to new artistic approaches forged in the wake of the two wars that marked the 20th century.
