Monday in March, free special tours

International Women's Day

In conjunction with the celebration of International Women's Day this Sunday, the Museum's Education Department has organised a series of thematic tours of works in the Permanent Collection, taking place every Monday in March from 9 March onwards. These tours are free of charge.

Women and power, Creative collaborations, Women and fashion and Women and art are the subjects to be encompassed in these tours, which focus on works selected by participants in the Museum's educational programmes and devised in collaboration with members of the Education Department and Volunteers team. Each tour is conceived as a conversation between one of our participants and a professional from the Department or a Volunteer, while dialogue with participating members of the public is also encouraged. Among the bodies supporting this initiative are FEAPS, Pueblos Unidos, the Latina Psycho-Social Rehabilitation Centre and the Committee for Research into Violence against Women.

This activity aims to highlight women's participation in the Museum's activities and their presence in this institution. It represents a continuation of the programme *Nosotras* [We Women], which focuses on gender projects devised by the Museum's Education Department over the past few years, and has arisen both from a desire to apply a gender perspective to the Museum's educational activities and from the demand from various women's groups who participate in some of our programmes. The *Nosotras* programme has included collaborations with other institutions and associations, seminars and tours of collections and has generated resources that re-examine the collection, all reflecting our educational strategy of shared knowledge.

Tours take place every Monday in March from 12.30pm to 1.30pm. Participants must register beforehand on the day of the tour at the meeting point in the Museum's entrance hall. Maximum 15 people per group.
