



The Museo Thyssen introduces a new single price ticket for visiting the Permanent Collection and temporary exhibitions

On 9 February, to coincide with the opening of the exhibition *Madrid Realists*, the Museum is introducing a single price ticket of 12 Euros that gives entry to both the temporary exhibitions and the Permanent Collection. Widely offered by most international museums and by museums in Madrid, this entry price offers a considerable advantage to visitors who, for a single and lower price than a combined ticket or than the sum of two separate visits, have access to more art for less money.

The price of 12 Euros is for a standard ticket, while the reduced price ticket will be 8 Euros and the group ticket 10 Euros (7 or more visitors).

The Museo Thyssen also offers visitors the chance to see the Permanent Collection for free every Monday throughout the year from 12 noon to 4pm.

The new single entry price will be introduced on 9 February to coincide with the exhibition *Madrid Realists*, the first exhibition of 2016, which will be followed this year by *Caravaggio and the Northern Painters*, *Renoir and intimacy*, *Wyeth: Andrew and Jamie in the Studio*, *Caillebotte, Painter and Gardener*, and *Bulgari. Passion for Rome*.

Reduced price tickets are available to visitors aged over 65, pensioners, students, holders of the Young People's Card, university professors of Fine Arts faculties, Large Families and Spanish citizens with over 33% disability. Entry is free for children aged under 12 accompanied by adults, members of ICOM and officially unemployed Spanish citizens.
