THE THYSSEN STEPS OUT

29 October 2011 to
 20 January 2012

Between 29 October 2011 and 20 January 2012 the Museo Thyssen-Bornemisza will be visiting 17 Immigrant Participation and Integration Centres (CEPIs) in the Region of Madrid in order to present and introduce the temporary exhibition *Architectural Paintings. From Renaissance to 18th Century* as part of its programme "The Thyssen Steps Out".

This project, sponsored by Fundación Barclays, will offer participants a voyage around Europe through the works of art in the exhibition. Free short talks to be given at the CEPIs will propose a journey in space and time in order to discover the places visited by travellers in past centuries. The aim is learn about the palaces, monuments and public spaces to be found in cities around Europe and thus to understand and participate in their culture.

In addition, the exhibition coincides with the project *Citizens for United Europe*, coordinated by the Office for Social Affairs of the Region of Madrid. This project aims to promote the active participation of all citizens in the construction of Europe. Through "The Thyssen Steps Out", the intention of both the Museum and Fundación Barclays is to encourage knowledge of European culture in order to facilitate the integration of the immigrant population living in Madrid.

As in previous editions of this activity, the talks will be followed up by guided tours* around the Museo Thyssen-Bornemisza led by members of EducaThyssen, the Museum's educational team.
